

CHESS CLUB RULES FOR PARENTS

- Chess Club will meet every other Wednesday, after school, from 1:30pm to 2:30pm in P-6. The club will not meet when school is not in session. The first date is October 16th and the last date in February 5th.

- There is a no fee per Chess Club session. PTSA funding will provide for snacks, chess supplies & tournament awards.
- Once you are accepted into the first session you are automatically accepted into the second session. We ask that if you choose to drop out of chess club you let us know ASAP in consideration of the waiting list.
- Please commit to playing chess with your child once a week. Inquire about concepts and skills gained and ask your child to demonstrate what they learned in their lesson.
- You child is joining chess club to learn and play chess. If your child is not playing chess they will be reminded of this fact. Continued problems will result in being asked not to return.

CHESS CLUB RULES FOR STUDENTS

1. Model good sportsmanship, as a player or spectator, before, during and after the game.
2. When asked to play politely accept offer. During your game play TOUCH-MOVE rules. Talk to your opponent if you would like to experiment with the move. After game use kind words and actions to acknowledge the winner and good play.
3. Handle Chess Club supplies carefully. When your game is finished, shake hands and reset the board. At clean up time, return the boards and pieces in their bags to the players' supply bin.
4. Ask an adult for help at chess club if you need it, for any reason.
5. Play chess at home with your family once a week and talk about what you learned at chess. There will be reminder handouts coming home with you to help.
6. Follow the Bob Cat Code : Be Safe, Be Kind, Do your Job
