- You may be asked to drive separately to Camp Warm Beach if space is limited on the student bus. Cars may not be left in the Cougar Ridge School parking lot since they will lock the yellow gates on the weekends.
- You may or may not be assigned to your child's group or activity times, unless required by my child's medical/social/physical needs.
- You might be asked to stay in the mini lodge (double bed) with 11 kids for supervision at night – a chaperone is required to be with the kids at night.
- You will need to follow all camp rules and regulations. Help fellow campers (adults and kids) to ensure the safety and security of all.

We will contact selected chaperones in the early March 2023 timeframe. At that time, if selected, you will be provided with camp registration form and waivers to complete for yourself.
